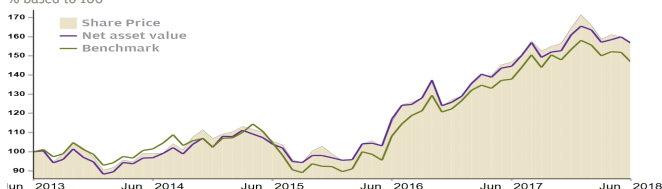

Management Commentary

The trust outperformed in May. Stock selection in the financials sector was the leading contributor to returns - in particular, pan-Asian insurer AIA Group reported strong first-quarter results. Additionally, Indian private sector bank IndusInd Bank added value, as it continued to deliver operationally and widen the performance gap with lower quality financial institutions in India following the scandal at ICICI. China aided performance in the month, thanks to exposure to Alibaba as the company reported strong revenue growth. However, stock selection in Brazil detracted from returns in May. Department store retailer Lojas Renner continued to face weaker-than-expected retail trends, driving the stock to underperform. Additionally, Itaú Unibanco sold off amid volatility in the market. In South Africa, stock selection and overweight exposure to the market was a headwind in May. Bidvest Group, a trading and distribution company, has seen earnings downgrades recently due to concerns over the pace of the country's economic recovery. The trust uses our comprehensive research platform to identify high quality businesses that compound earnings sustainably over long periods, resulting in a long-term, high conviction portfolio with a quality and growth bias.

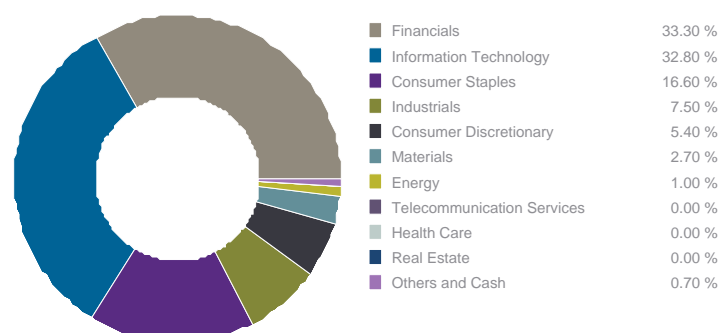

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

BENCHMARK COMPARISON - Comparison of the Company's performance is made with the benchmark. The benchmark is a recognised index of stocks which should not be taken as wholly representative of the Company's investment universe. The Company's investment strategy does not follow or track this index and therefore there may be a degree of divergence between its performance and that of the Company.

CASH - Net current assets including investment in liquidity funds & treasury stocks (if held) and drawn revolving credit facilities (if any) with an original maturity of less than 1 year.

DISCOUNT / PREMIUM - If the share price of an investment company is lower than the net asset value (NAV) per share, the company is said to be trading at a discount. If the share price of an investment company is higher than the net asset value (NAV) per share, the company is said to be trading at a premium. The discount/premium is shown as a percentage of the NAV.

GEARING - Gearing represents the excess amount above shareholders' funds of total assets expressed as a percentage of the shareholders' funds. Total assets include total investments and net current assets/liabilities less cash/cash equivalents and excluding bank loans of less than one year. If the amount calculated is negative this is known as a 'net cash' position.

SECTOR / GEOGRAPHICAL BREAKDOWNS - These are expressed as a percentage of total portfolio and cash. Investments in liquidity funds will be shown as cash.

TOP 10 HOLDINGS - These are expressed as a percentage of total portfolio and cash. Investments in liquidity funds / treasury stocks will not be shown in the top 10 holdings.
